



**Memorandum of Understanding  
between  
Naresuan University, Thailand  
and  
Cambodian Institute for Cooperation and Peace, Cambodia**

In order to promote co-operation between Naresuan University, Thailand and the Cambodian Institute for Cooperation and Peace, Cambodia, the two institutions agree as follows:

Each Institute will encourage direct contact and co-operation among their Faculty, Administrative Staff, Departments, and Research Centers.

The fields of particular interest involve: bilateral relations between Cambodia and Thailand, regional security and integration and their challenges, peace building, sustainable development and social responsibility, good governance, human development and human security, climate change issues, and regional migration. Within these fields, the following general forms of co-operation will be pursued:

- Visits by and exchange of staff for teaching and research
- Visits by and exchange of graduate/undergraduate students for study and research
- The sharing of resources, including the exchange of library materials and research publications
- The establishment of a Khmer Studies Center at Naresuan University and the establishment of a Thai Studies Corner at the Cambodian Institute for Cooperation and Peace
- Joint research activities in relevant fields to promote mutual interests

Both parties understand that all financial arrangements related to the above general forms of cooperation will be consulted and agreed upon first based on the principle of mutual respect and the availability of funds.


Specific details for the implementation of these activities will be developed mutually by both sides for particular projects. These projects will be considered as outcomes of this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU), and they will be made available for the public to promote academic interest upon approval from the two institutions.

If the MOU remains dormant for three consecutive years, it will be deemed to have lapsed. Where the MOU continues to be active, the two institutions agree to review it after five years from the date of signature. It may be terminated at any time by mutual consent or by six months' notice in writing by either party.

There will be no financial commitment from either party, unless specified by a further agreement.
