Submission Guidelines

- Manuscript Length: Research articles should be 3000 to 4000 words (including references), while review essays and policy briefs may vary from 2,000–3,000 words.
- **Format**: Manuscripts should be double-spaced, with references in APA style (7th edition).
- **Abstract**: Each submission must include an abstract of no more than 250 words and up to five keywords.
- **Originality**: Submissions must be original, previously unpublished work, and not under consideration elsewhere.
- **Peer Review**: All submissions will undergo a rigorous blind peer review process to ensure the highest academic standards.
